Inside Unit 731: Japan's Secret Human Experiments

Unit 731 was Japan's most secretive WWII programme – a biological warfare unit experimenting on humans,

based in Harbin, China. Rare access to the last remaining unit member Hideo Shimizu, survivors and newly declassified archives reveal the shocking scale of harm inflicted on Chinese, British and American victims, and the secret post-war deal with the USA which hid these atrocities, until now.



The Last Burma Star

Burma was one of the most brutal theatres of WWII and this documentary honours the Burmese soldiers who fought alongside British and Commonwealth forces. Join Major Levison Wood and historian Alex Bescoby as they pay tribute to the last surviving Burmese veterans and search for a 100-year-old soldier, to deliver his long-overdue Burma Star medal.



Revenge: Our Dad the Nazi Killer

Three brothers stumble upon a family secret: their father, a Holocaust survivor, allegedly killed a Nazi in Sydney in the 1950s. This gripping documentary asks when, if ever, is taking the law into your own hands justified?



The Day the War Ended

The Japanese surrender on August 15, 1945 ended World War II. But the people of Taiwan, who were under Japanese rule for the previous 50 years, suddenly became "Chinese", changing from losers to victors overnight. With their wartime experiences later buried in Taiwan's political turmoil, coloured archive and eyewitness accounts uncover this fascinating, lost chapter of history for the first time.



Edward vs George: The Windsors at War

At the outbreak of World War II, the British monarchy was in turmoil. Edward VIII had abdicated, leaving his brother George to take on a role he never expected: King. Escape from Chernobyl: 48 Hours That Changed the World

Alice Roberts returns to uncover more archaeological treasures from the most exciting digs in the UK. Si Thep: Ancient Civilisation of the Sun God

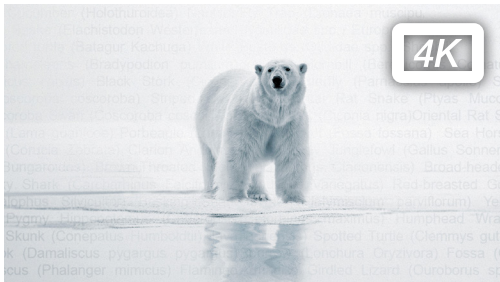


Trump and the Tech Giants

USA: The War on Gender

The American Abortion War

Abortion rights are under threat in the US. Texas - where the practice is banned - is on the frontline of this debate which is tearing the nation apart. The Ozempic Effect: Beyond the Waistline

Addicted: Inside the Global Drugs Trade

Drug addiction is a global crisis, with over half a million people dying from drug abuse each year. Our reporters travel the world to expose the narcos behind the illicit production, trafficking and consumption of mainstream and synthetic drugs, from fentanyl in North America and meth in Myanmar, to cocaine in Colombia and Europe.



China After Dark
